A producer's job is to find a story to put on screen. They are in charge of everything from start to finish. They find a screenplay or hire a writer. When the script is officially done, the producer finds an executive producer, who finds the money. Sometimes big investors will insist on the E.P title. The producer will then hire a production manager or a line producer to put together the logistical plan to make the movie. They then hire a director to be fully responsible for the image that finally ends up on screen. When the scenes are all shot the producer gets an editor to do the final touches on the production. When the movie is finish editing, the producer make sure the finish production is distributed, through a company.
