Q. What is contained in a director's workbook?

A. A shooting script, shot list, storyboards, blocking sheets, character notes,

Q. What does it mean to "line the shooting script?"

A. This serves to help time the shots, long shots, medium...

Q. What is the most important thing for a director to do before shooting has even started? What makes it vital to the process?

A. Shot list! Prepare! Securing locations, permits, insurance, evacuation routes, planning for bad weather, have a plan and a back up plan for the back up plan. If the director skimps on preparation it will show in the film -getting behind costs money!
