1.) What is contained in a director's workbook?

The director's workbook will contain everything needed for every scene in the movie. (Usually, a 3-ring binder holding a shooting script (lined), a shot list, storyboards, blocking sheets, character notes, and any tear sheets deemed necessary.)

2.) What does it mean to "line the shooting script?"

A lined script is a script that has vertical lines drawn down the length of the page from the beginning of the shot to the end of the shot. The purpose of a line script is to gauge how long the shots are.

3.) What is the most important thing for a director to do before shooting has even started? What makes it vital to the process?

Preparation is vital to the entire production. And the shot list is the vital tool used by directors prior to commence shooting. The shot list determines exactly what you must film and how you will film it. It's a way to always have answers or solutions to any arising issues and stay ahead by anticipating any potential shooting problems or malfunctions.
